

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Part 1: Project Introduction

1.1 Main Concept

Through a creative combination of artworks and urban space, *Finding and Fun* project is aiming to inspire Hong Kong people to find art in their daily life and realize the neglected beauty of the ordinary urban space. We want to bring art out of galleries and museums, exhibit artworks in certain unnoticeable places and encourage people to seek for this interesting street exhibition.

We think art should not only be preserved in art institutions or just cater to high-educated elites. Therefore our project would make art much more accessible to everybody. Local residents can easily start an art trip in their leisure time without waiting to entrance a museum. Even the person who is just passing by the exhibition venue can also enjoy an unexpected art display. What is more, we would also organize several participatory activities, which are based on our street exhibition and encourage people to recreate new artworks. By all these means, the project would bring a new perspective of contemporary art to Hong Kong and inject a new cultural connotation into local business district.

In addition, the artworks we would exhibit are mainly focusing on modern people's life and express the stressful, lonely and isolated emotion state of them. As we all know, Hong Kong is a busy, rushed city and the fast-paced work life may lead people under a high-pressure situation. Besides work life, their private life is being squeezed and people are isolated from one another. Thus we think the artistic expression of the artworks also fits in local life condition. Apart from an art adventure, we also hope our project can trigger people to reflect on their inner emotions.

1.2 Project Outcome

Finding and Fun project guides people to some ordinary places and leads them to find artworks by themselves. Through these, we hope the visitors who involve in our exhibition can realize that art is not something should always be kept in a museum or a

gallery and our daily life can easily relate to the artistic activities. Moreover, our project also attempts to arouse the enthusiasm of the visitors and simulate their passion to find art in everyday life.

Apart from the street exhibition, we would also hold several participatory activities, such as online photo exhibition, sculpture workshop, seminar etc. During all of these activities, people can produce various recreations based on our exhibited artworks and transmit their recreations through different media. So the artistic concept and the artworks are able to spread from person to person in a liberal, nontraditional, boarder way. Furthermore, by encouraging participators to produce their recreations, we believe that the whole process of our project would foster participators' artistic creativity and give full play to the educational function of an artistic project.

Additionally, by introducing a good example of street art, we hope to diversify contemporary art environment in Hong Kong. As we know, Hong Kong is a commercial-leading city and most of the urban space is functional. So *Finding and Fun* project would add some interesting artworks into local business district. At the same time, the urban decorations would attract further audiences out of their homes to enjoy an open-air exhibition and gain much more artistic attention among local community. Moreover, we also hope our project can motivate other original creations of street art in Hong Kong and let them integrate into daily life.

1.3 Project Content

1.3.1 Exhibition

1) Exhibition Form

The artist we intend to invite, Isaac Cordal, is a sculptor and most of his works are tiny sculptures, which are always combined with urban environment in a smart, innovative way when being displayed. Therefore we would select three narrow alleys in Mong Kok and install the tiny sculptures by using the original architectural environment inside them.

Then we would design an art map, which indicates the roughly venue of our exhibition, and hand them out to the audiences. So they can follow the indication and go to find the artworks in this interesting art adventure.

Here are some examples about how Isaac Cordal install his exhibition:














2) Why choose this form

Interactivity

Interact with the urban space

The sculpture will be displayed in a creative way to engage with their surroundings.

The artist would make use of those architectural space of the alley to create a nontraditional exhibition –a harmonious coexistence.

Interact with the visitor

Visitors would cease to be a passive spectators, on the contrary, they need to find the art works and specific exhibition venue. Visitors will find the sculpture in an unexpected place and will enjoy the joviality of finding. The Interactivity of this exhibition would provide a renewed sense of street art.

· The process is fun

In traditional exhibitions, the visitors will go to the exhibition venue directly when they get the information about the exhibition. But Finding and Fun project encourage you to find by yourself, the specific venue of each sculpture would not be told but a roughly area.

Moreover, in the process of finding, something will be produced:

New recognition of the city

For local people, this project inject new vitality to this business district. The exhibition also provides an opportunity to drill down to the small alley for them where they seldom visit in daily life. For nonlocal people, the cluttered and narrow alley will makes great contradiction to those delicate, brilliant office building which will bring new recognition of Hong Kong. They will have a new impression beyond the bustling marketplaces, skyscrapers and big city lights.

Happy time with families, friends or strangers

The modernized style of life in Hong Kong has resulted in isolation between people, people have immersed in busy work and ignored the family life. You can find the exhibition with your families or friends and have a joyful day. In addition, you may expanded the scope and diversity of your social circles in the process of finding.

As a reflection of Hong Kong people's life

A report from hospital authority has shown that the population of people got depression in Hong Kong is triple that of world average. It is generally known that Hong Kong people lived in a fast-paced and stressful society with small average housing area. The tiny sculptures which exhibited in urban space is a reflection of the lives of Hong Kong people: a single person struggles with this metropolis. In this way, this project will resonate people a lot and help them face the loneliness.

3) Exhibition Place

Exhibition venue: Three alleys in Mong Kok

We choose Mong Kok as our exhibition venue due to four reasons:

Mong Kok and Local Culture

All kinds of local or indigenous culture brings together in Mong Kok. Mong Kok preserves its traditional characteristics with an array of markets, small shops, and food stalls that have disappeared from other areas during the past several decades of economic developments and urban transformation. The process of finding in Mong Kok is a good way to learn native culture for nonlocal people. This project will also injected new connotation and new vitality to the indigenous culture in Mong Kok, thus enhancing the culture atmosphere there.

· The multiple population composition in Mong Kok

We choose Mong Kok as our exhibition also due to the diverse population there. This exhibition welcomes ordinary people from all walks of life in Mong Kok, such as street vendors, dustman, white-collar workers. On the field trip to Mong Kok, we have noticed that a phenomenon that all kinds of people often stand near the alley entrance to have a telephone call or chat for rest. Visiting the exhibition in alleys will be a good choice for them to enrich their life in spare time, and cultivate their passion for art.

The fitness of the alleys

Mong Kok is the traditional commercial and retail center with a large stream of people. People are too busy to overlook or even destruct the tiny sculpture on the main street. So we choose three small alleys in order to protect the sculpture and let visitor find the tiny sculpture more easily. Moreover, many beautiful scene in small alley such as one-line-sky, tight maze of pipes and the mottled walls constitute the unique alley aesthetics. The fine scenery in the alley is the part of urban landscape that can't be ignored by both Hong Kong people and outsiders. We want to catch people's eyes to the beauty in alleys through this exhibition.

· Convenient transportation

With developed traffic ,people from every district of Hong Kong can go to Mong Kok directly by bus or MTR(East Rail line, Tsuen Wan line and Kwun Tong line). It still have shuttle bus run all night.



1.3.2 Other Activities

Besides the exhibition itself, there are three other activities we would hold to diversify this project, targeting different kinds of audience. And these activities will also become a part of our promotion during the exhibition period.

1) Online Photo Exhibition

Theme: Finding and Fun

Participant: people who visit our exhibition

Aim: to enrich the effect and result of visiting the exhibition

Content:

We would encourage visitors to take photos of those tiny sculptures to show what they see during the visiting process. Then send their photos to us, and we will put their photos in our Facebook page. Everyone can search our page and visit it to choose his/her favorite photos. At the end of the online exhibition, we will count the most popular photos and award the photographers.

To inspire the enthusiasm to participate in this activity, we will prepare some prizes for

those photographers. After the result comes out, we will send them some souvenirs like mug cups (for third prize, three persons), canvas bags (for second prize, two persons) and photo frame (for first prize, one person) with our project logo on them (conceptual images of prizes refer to the Appendix).

This exhibition will start simultaneously with the main exhibition of our project, but last a bit longer than the main exhibition so that people could have more time to choose their favorite photos.

2) Workshop

Theme: Making My Own Sculpture

Place: C&G Apartment

Participant: people who like DIY, not just for kids

Aim: To make some differences of the district and bring some new cultural connotation

to the streets

Content:

This is a hands-on activity. People can register this activity online for free. During the workshop artist will teach people how to make tiny sculptures. And we will prepare some clay and tools for our participants. After the workshop, people can decide whether to keep their sculptures or to put them in some the corners. Besides, we believe the process of making the sculptures and finding the proper corners to place their sculptures will help people understand more about Mong Kok and the streets. In addition, those tiny sculptures will also bring some special meaning to the streets.

3) Seminar Brute other people besides the

Theme: Street Art and the Urban Space artist.

Place: CUHK

Participant: University students

Aim: To make street art and our exhibition more understandable

Content:

We will open the registration a few weeks before the seminar and people can register online. We will also provide some sits for walk-in registration.

The theme of this seminar might be changed after we discuss with our artist. But we want to invite Isaac to share his ideas of street art, and how he create his artworks. We believe it will be a good chance for all of us to understand more about Isaac and his art. It is also a chance to discuss and think about street art and how does it influence or

change the situation of the urban space. Besides, people who participate in either workshop or seminar will receive a badge with our program logo as a souvenir.

Part 2: The Artist—Isaac Cordal

2.1 Introduction of Isaac Cordal

The artist we would like to invite is a Spanish sculptor, Isaac Cordal, now living in London. He has been creating tiny sculptures for years and most of his artworks convey a strong expression towards human emotions and social issues.

His ongoing series entitled Cement Eclipses—a nomad project, which began in art school in 2002. But the first exhibition of this project hold at Vigo, Spain until 2006. In this project, he installed his cement miniature sculptures in many cities, as a kind of metamorphosis of the urban scenery. Unlike ordinary sculptures, the uniqueness of Isaac Cordal's sculpture installation is the creative exhibition form and the harmonious combination with the urban environment. The cement miniature sculptures always hiding among streets, in many unusual and unlikely places, such as rain gutters, the wire netting, or just the top of a fire-hydrant cabinet. Generally, these places are too ordinary to arouse people's attention. But Cordal catches the distinctive aesthetics of these places and uses his sensitive eyes to develop a different and interesting scene via small-scale interventions. Through the miniature landscape in big city, he embodies the spirit of guerrilla street art. By now, his work has been installed in many metropolises, like Berlin, London, Brussels, Liege, Barcelona and Vigo etc.

Beside of bringing new meaning to little corners of the urban environment, Cordal's figures also express human emotions in a sympathetic and profound way. He always manages to capture a lot of emotion in his miniature landscape, and arouse people's resonance with their situations. When people passing by, some lucky ones may see the 'little man's life story' in street corner: their leisure time, their waiting for buses and their more tragic moments such as accidental death, suicide or family funerals. With these common, life-like scenes, the spectators are easy to relate to their own life and perhaps want to communicate with them.

2.2 Why we choose Isaac Cordal

2.2.1 A good example of street art

Cordal uses his street art as a way of combat, a way of expressing his ideas, and a sort of activism. In Isaac's words, "I'm not trying to tell jokes. I'm aiming for a more critical kind of art." His art is not just purposing to amaze people or create something new, but also to catch the attention through a critical look to the loneliness and alienation of modern life.

At the same time, Cordal's artworks also concern about some of the important social issues, such as global warming, reflection of World War, historical events and so on. His artworks demonstrate these subjects in an ironical, vivid way and the powerful meaning inside them may trigger people to rethink about their life and the society.

2.2.2 Thought-provoking Connotation

Nowadays we live in a highly-developed world, it is seems that everybody shares the same life trace. From school age, everyone gets almost the same values served up, the same upbringing, and is taught to see the same horizon and to have the same ideas. Therefore by repeating the same model in series, Cordal manufactures a prototype representing human beings in modern world and through that evoking people to rethink about their own identity and find their distinctive characteristics.

Moreover, with the creative exhibited form, Cordal's little cement people are like living in the real world. His tiny sculptures can serve as a symbol of reality, of the one percent of the population, and of the interlacement of politics and economics. Thus apart from the artwork itself, the connotation of Isaac Cordal's art would also trigger the spectator think deeply, in a profound way.

2.2.3 The distinctive expression within local cultural context

Isaac Cordal is a sensitive artist who can grasp the characteristics of a city and express them precisely. For the past few years, a group of little cement figures have been exhibited in many metropolises, Cordal could always engender sparks of amazement within urban space and local cultural context. For instance, when the sculptures exhibited in Mexico in July 2014, Cordal let his small figures to wear the local costume; when they traveled to Berlin, Cordal set them standing on the Berlin Wall, which seems to be the witness of history.

With the thought of 'figurines represent a kind of metamorphosis', Cordal add his distinctive expression in the sculptures in different cities. As for these reasons, we would like to bring his wonderful artworks to Hong Kong as a refreshment of local culture context. And we believe his street exhibition would provide a new cultural definition to Mong Kok.




180 Creative Camp, Abrantes. Portugal August 22, 2014

Last September Isaac participated in BLK River Festival in Vienna. He made some ephemeral installations as well as some permanent installation in the streets during the Festival.








If you are dissatisfied with the decision made by the Director, you may within 28 days after the service on you of the notice declaring the decision appeal to the Municipal Services Appeals Board in accordance with the relevant section of the Regulations.




